

# Car Camping Gear Checklist

## **Clothing (bring extra in case you get wet):**

- Hiking Shoes (preferred over tennis shoes)
- Socks
- Pants
- Shirts
- Under Garments
- Jacket
- Hat
- Class A Uniform (travel to/from event)
- Class B Uniform (wear during the day)
- Swim Suit
- Towel

## **Equipment:**

- Backpack (makes it easy to carry stuff)
- Sleeping Bag (20 degree bag)
- Thermarest
- Small Pillow
- Tent
- Ground Cloth
  
- Mess Kit (Bowl, Cup, Spoon, Fork, Knife)
- Water Bottle (filled with water)
- Travel Kit (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
  
- Trash Bag (put wet stuff in)
- Pocket Knife/Leatherman
- Toten Chip
- Headlamp/Flashlight
- Batteries
  
- First Aid Kit (Band-aids, Moleskin, etc.)
- Sunscreen
- Lip Balm (with sun block)
- Bug Repellent
- Snack (Powerbar, etc.)
  
- Rope (clothes line, etc.)
- Duct Tape
  
- Scout Book (put in plastic bag)

## **Optional:**

- Cell Phone (for emergency use only)
- Camera
- Book (put in plastic bag)
- Money (some is needed for summer camp)
- Fold-Up Chair

## **Do Not Bring:**

- Radio, TV, or electronic games
- Aerosol products
- Alcohol, tobacco, or other illegal substances
- Firearms, bows and arrows, sling shots
- Fixed blade knives
- Pets

## **Troop-Supplied Equipment:**

- Patrol boxes (stoves, fuel, pans, utensils)
- Patrol canopy

## **Notes:**
